Centre for Early Childhood Development	To provide an ECD entrepreneurship programme to 200 ECD principals citywide. Provides mentoring and support and will assist ECD management towards sustainability.
Ikamva Labantu	To support local ECDs towards sustainability by providing mentoring and support through a principals' training programme over 10 months. Operates in Khayelitsha, Gugulethu, Philippi, Nyanga, Langa Empilweni and New Crossroads.
Ubuntu Circle of Courage	The reintegration of street people. Provision of a six-month developmental training programme aimed at assisting people living on the street with reintegration.
U-Turn Homeless Ministries	Provision of drop in services/service centres for persons living on the street, aimed at restoring dignity and development of persons living on the street, motivating them to enter a shelter and possible reintegration.
Khulisa Social Solutions	To provide job creation and interventions to reconnect group with their families and move off the street. Provision of drop in services/service centres for persons living on the street, aimed at restoring dignity and development, motivating them to enter a shelter and possible reintegration.

National Sea Rescue Institute	<p>A drowning prevention programme focused at youth in response to incidents recorded in high drowning areas. Will be implemented at the following beaches: Strand, Monwabisi, Melkbosstrand and Strandfontein.</p>
Young Bafana HHH Soccer Academy	<p>Youth development through sports education. Programme will be implemented in the following areas: Lwandle, Zola and Nomzamo in Strand.</p> <p>Number of beneficiaries: 50</p>
Sonke Gender Justice	<p>Capacity building of men and boys in school to prevent and respond to HIV/AIDS and gender-based violence in the city. Programme will be implemented in Gugulethu, Delft and Philippi.</p> <p>Number of beneficiaries: 85 per quarter</p>
Mosaic Training Service and Healing Centre for women	<p>Empowering men programme ending violence against women and girls by an integrated and holistic approach that includes men in the conversation and programmatic efforts. Programme will be implemented in Area North, East, South and Central.</p>

Learn to Earn	<p>A woodwork project focused on providing unemployed men with woodwork skills so that they can become economically active. Khayelitsha and surrounds.</p> <p>Number of beneficiaries: 12</p>
Cape Mental Health	<p>Focus on three special education and care centres in Heideveld, Khayelitsha and Mitchells Plain to provide daycare and special educare programmes for children/youth with severe and profound intellectual disabilities.</p> <p>Number of beneficiaries: 186</p>
Afrika Burn	Series of artistic skills development workshops that link young emerging/marginalised artists and art collectives/organisations to established practitioners.
Africa Centre: Borderlands Project	A multi-dimensional training programme aimed at empowering youth from segregated communities: creative skills development, arts training, professional connection and exposure. Instils critical, creative thinking and active engagement with social and environmental issues. Masiphumelele, Ocean View, Kommetjie, Sun Valley, Simonstown, etc.

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Baxter Theatre	#Just Men production. #JustMen is a multi-lingual, docudrama performed by 4 award-winning South African actors sharing their own deeply personal stories in a call to activism against gender-based violence. The show highlights a range of connected issues including rape and domestic abuse, and calls men to account. Lavendar Hill, Atlantis, Ocean View, Strand, Elsie's River, Khayelitsha, Delft, Lotus River, Cape Flats, Gugulethu and others.
Institute for Music and Indigenous Arts Development	IMAD operates in disadvantaged Cape Town areas, providing music tuition to vulnerable children and youth. They aim to enable them to develop an interest and an expertise which will give them the opportunity for a career in music and an alternative to other negative influences in their lives. Impact area: Khayelitsha.
Indoni Dance Arts and Leadership Academy	Development of performances at Green Point Park, Khayelitsha Wetlands Park and Nantes Park with Indoni graduates teaching youth-at-risk through 'outreach'. Provides opportunity for 'on the job training' for trainees, and motivation, stimulation and life skills for youngsters. Philippi, Langa, Khayelitsha, Nyanga East, Bellville
Jazzart	Choreography workshop for youth from impoverished areas to be showcased at the DCAS Kaap Se Dans Solo Performance at Artscape and the touring of the solos and Jazzart dance pieces to schools. Philippi, Delft, Langa, Khayelitsha, Gugulethu
Jungle Theatre	Partnering with Sozo Youth Foundation to train beneficiaries in performing arts skills with a view to the transference of these skills, adding to the development and employability of youth. Vrygrond and Lavender Hill

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Magnet Training and Youth Upliftment Trust	Culture Gangs Project: support programme for existent drama groups in CT townships providing theatre skills, creative thinking and play – affirming identity and encouraging youth to commit to culture rather than gangs. Vrygrond, Nyanga East, Khayelitsha, Gugulethu, Du Noon, Samora Machel.
Musiquelaine South Africa	A music programme run at Steenberg High School to promote music education amongst disadvantaged youth. Retreat and surrounds
Rainbow Arts	'Our culture Our nation': cultural training and development initiative for youth that includes individual drama, dance, poetry and music programmes through the year. The project is a 'training based programme which aims to reach disadvantaged committed young people in Delft community and surrounding areas.'
Siyakholwa Youth Development	Programme run in partnership with schools to develop their music offering into an after-schools programme with qualified teachers for youth at risk in Eindhoven, Delft and surrounds.
Spieël	Time to Thrive – arts therapy based programme using visual arts, drama, play, written activities and reflection to assist learners to build self-esteem, confidence, leadership etc. Targets Grade 11 learners. Athlone and Nyanga
