The host organisation for the trip was Cape Town Carnival. The delegation was hosted by Professor Rachel Jaftha - Chairperson of the Cape Town Carnival and Jay Douwes - CEO of Cape Town Carnival. In addition the city delegation was hosted by the Mayor of Rio de Janeiro, Mr Eduardo Paes, the Manager of International Affairs - Mr Guilermo Villegas and Ms Luna de Silva - Social Diversity Unit. The host organisation Cape Town Carnival has an exchange relationship with the Rio Carnival and agreed to host the city delegation to discuss the possibility of extending the nature and scale of the Cape Town Carnival.

4. OBJECTIVE

The first reason for attending was to review the role and nature of the Cape Town Carnival through the comparative assessment of the Rio Carnival which is the biggest and best and longest in the world. The primary aim was to determine the possible growth trajectory and strategy for taking the Cape Town Carnival forward over the next 3 to 5 years.

The second reason was to consider ways and means of extending an invitation to the winners of the Rio carnival to participate in the Cape Town Carnival.

And the third reason was to reconnect with Rio de Janeiro as one of Cape Town's sister cities. Mayor Paes is the current chairperson of teh C40 group of cities on climate change.

OUTCOMES

Cape Town Carnival currently receives an annual grant from the City with the bulk of its funding (more than 75%) coming from the private sector. The grant is governed by an annual Memorandum of agreement. The request was to conclude a 3 year deal with the City in order to stabilise the financial relationship between the City and the Carnival. The city requested that Cape Town Carnival present its 3 or 5 year strategy before committing to any funding beyond an annual basis.

The second outcome was for Cape Town Carnival to conclude a cooperation agreement with the Rio carnival to consider exchanging costumes and float materials as well as any other technical requirements that may improve and support the Cape Town Carnival.

6. ACTIONS REQUIRED

Cape Town Carnival is requested to submit a proposed 3 year deal with the City in order to stabilise the financial relationship between the City and the Carnival. The city requested that Cape Town Carnival present its 3 or 5 year strategy before committing to any funding beyond an annual basis.

Cape Town Carnival is requested to provide an update as to whether it was able to secure a cooperation agreement with the Rio Carnival especially as it relates to an exchange agreement, technical support on floats and garments and financial modelling for its future growth.
