PROVIDE SUMMARY OF HOST ORGANISATION / CITY

In early 2023, the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), launched a project called "Generation Restoration: Catalysing a nature-based transformation in finance, jobs and cities", (2023-2025) with the objective to implement a package of measures to address targeted political, technical, and financial challenges to promote ecosystem restoration in urban areas, in the framework of the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration and Global Biodiversity Framework (especially Target 12). Cities, as hubs for human activity, wield significant influence over ecosystems. By extension, empowering cities to take action is critical to harness the power of urban ecosystem restoration.

The City was invited in May 2023 by UNEP in partnership with ICLEI: Local Governments for Sustainability. Specifically, ICLEI approached the City as one of its member cities and host to its Africa office, to lodge a submission to become a Role Model City for Urban Ecosystem Restoration.

A submission was made in July 2023, together with a letter of support from Alderman Andrews on behalf of the City for the City to take on a Role Model City role. After a formal adjudication process, UNEP and ICLEI notified the City on 19 September 2023 that our submission was successful. This led to the City being invited to share its expertise with Pilot Cities and participate in this global cities capacity building workshop.

4. OBJECTIVE

The UNEP / ICLEI team invited two technical specialists to represent each city at the in-person workshop. Two officials, Mr Bongani Mnisi (Manager: Environmental Planning & Sustainability) and Dr Charmaine Oxtoby (Biophysical Specialist) from the Environmental Management Department represented the City and presented on the City's Functional Ecological Connectivity and Biodiversity Management Restoration projects.

The objective of the workshop was to foster collaboration and knowledge exchange by bringing together representatives from Pilot and Role Model Cities, donors and global experts. The workshop specifically covered the following:

- Connecting and learning from the expertise and experience across all Generation Restoration cities;
- Gaining concrete ideas of how to implement and scale up urban ecosystem restoration projects;
- Engaging with UNEP and ICLEI experts and exploring further opportunities for collaboration and engagement as part of the Generation Restoration project, and beyond;
- Identifying opportunities for collaboration across cities and regions, with donors and experts; and,
- Establishing a global network of like-minded practitioners to lay the grounds for close collaboration until December 2025.

The direct interaction with and learning from other global cities will enhanced Cape Town's urban ecosystem restoration projects. The officials interacted with donor organisations, which opened opportunities for linkages to be formed regarding potential funding assistance for City of Cape Town's projects outside of this initiative.

5. OUTCOMES

While there are no binding outcomes for the City stemming from the workshop, it should be noted that all Role Model and Pilot Cities are expected to reconvene in March 2025. Before then, there will be various online exchange programmes planned and facilitated by UNEP and ICLEI that will ensure continuous learning from each other.

6. ACTIONS REQUIRED

No actions required, however, cities have been encouraged to keep sharing information and promote knowledge exchanges. Dates for the next in-person workshop and online exchanges will also be shared in the next couple of months.
