Noncommunicable diseases (NCDs), which include heart disease, stroke, cancer, diabetes, and chronic respiratory diseases—and injuries are responsible for over 80% of all deaths globally. This poses significant risk to health and wellness and reaching sustainable development goals.

With a majority of the world's population now living in urban settings, ensuring the health and wellbeing of residents in our world's urban centers is crucial.

*Participating Cities are thus uniquely positioned to transform the fight against NCDs and injuries and implement policies to significantly reduce exposure to risk factors.*
