<p>Africa Leadership Initiative (ALI) has served as a Pan-African initiative with a strong view that Africa's future lies in the investment and development of effective, values-based and enlightened African leaders.</p> <p>The Africa Leadership Initiative's objectives are to develop the next generation of values-based African leaders.</p> <p>ALI forms part of the Aspen Global Leadership Network (AGLN). This network was established worldwide in collaboration with the Aspen Institute, and consists of other leadership initiatives similar to ALI.</p> <p>The Africa Leadership Initiative also spans across Africa. It is represented in three regions: ALI West Africa, ALI East Africa and ALI South Africa.</p> <p>The ALI Fellowship Programme provides a unique mixture of seminars, designed to broaden the perspectives of the participants and develop value-based, community-spirited leaders.</p> <p>They pull together leaders from various sectors of influence such as business, government and civil society.</p>	

4. OBJECTIVE

The Director for Enterprise and Investment, Lance Greyling, was admitted as a fellow of the African Leadership Initiative in 2018, of which commitment comprises attending 3 leadership seminars in South Africa and one international seminar that brings together fellows from the other chapters of

the Aspen Global Leadership Network across the world. This trip was for the Director to participate in this 6-day intensive globalization seminar and form networks with the other leadership fellows from around the world.

5. OUTCOMES

There were not specific resolutions that were reached that have a bearing on the City of Cape Town Municipality, but the seminar itself proved to be invaluable in terms of the discussion around ethical leadership and confronting some of the global challenges all are faced with in the respective countries of attendees. The value of this seminar really lay in the quality of the individuals participating in it and the Director for Enterprise and Investment made a number of important contacts such as the head of the Investment Committee for the Gates Energy Fund, who has expressed an interest to the Director in coming to Cape Town to possibly fund renewable energy projects.


