The World Bank together with the Jakarta Provincial Government were the organisers of this conference.

The World Bank's Urban Lab Programme aims to exchange and explore successful solutions utilised by the cities with regards to urban transformation challenges.

**4. OBJECTIVE**

The Jakarta Urban Lab formed part of a series of knowledge exchange events, organised by the World Bank, that have taken place since November 2018.

The first event was held in Medellin, Columbia in November 2018. the second event was held in July 2019 in Cape Town. The Jakarta Urban Lab, held in December 2019 in Indonesia, was the 3rd in the series of events.

Through these Urban Labs, participants are exposed to:

- peer learning, networking and discussions;
- presentations and panel discussions from global experts; and
- site inspections to observe current problems or be exposed to innovative solutions.

The urban lab experience aims to exchange and explore knowledge pertaining to successful solutions utilised by the other cities with regards to urban transformation challenges and explore the approaches being adopted toward addressing these challenges by other cities. The knowledge exchange events are aimed to not just provide context and content but also aims to establish a network of contacts with other cities and organisations with which cities can interact into the future to exchange knowledge.


