PROVIDE SUMMARY OF HOST ORGANISATION / CITY

The Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) was establihised in 2003 and aims to contribute to the promotion of international cooperation as well as the sound development of Japanese and global economy by supporting the socioeconomic development, recovery or economic stability of developing regions. It presents a wide range of training opportunties on a wide range of subject matter as part of their Knowledge Co-creation Programme.

The course was hosted by JICA in collaboration with the Japanese National Police Agency.

4. OBJECTIVE

The course objectives were to share Japan's experience in countering terrorism with the representatives of the 18 countries who attended the course and for all attendees to share knowledge on the subject matter.

The Safety and Security Directorate's objective was to learn from the different country representatives and identify those aspects that can be of use by the Directorate despite its limited role in the countering of international terrorism. Dr. Anton Visser was nominated due to the fact that he has a combination of research, management and operational experience to ensure that the benefits of the course can be effectively brought back to the City and implemented as required. He is the Safety and Security Directorate's support manager and in this capacity he has, amongst others, drafted an SOP for critical communications in the Directorate's response to a terrorist attack and oversaw the delivery of courses on weapons of mass destruction by US experts to a number of the City's policing and emergency service personnel.

5. OUTCOMES

Valuable knowledge was obtained that will be shared within the Directorate or incorporated into policies and procedures where appropriate. More importantly, a network was established for purposes of knowledge sharing that includes the representatives from all countries who attended and the Japanese National Policy Agency. It is believed that additional training opportunities will also result from this relationship.
