PROVIDE SUMMARY OF HOST ORGANISATION

The Food and Agriculture Agency (FAO) and Arbor Day Foundation partnered with other organisations to organise the forum. The Arbor Day Foundation sponsored my visit.

They work primarily in the United States to promote tree-planting in a variety of situations such as disaster-stricken areas, underserved neighborhoods in addition to fostering environmental justice in communities around the world <u>https://www.arborday.org/programs/</u>.

4. OBJECTIVE

The World Forum on Urban Forests' technical committee selected me to present a keynote speech as part of the Resilient Cities day activities. I was also invited to present a keynote at the "From concrete to Canopy: restoring Biodiversity and Ecosystems through Urban Forests by the UN Envrionment Programme.

The purpose of my visit was therefore to deliver the keynotes and participate in other forum activities. During the event I connected with scientists working in Southern California, an area that has also been exposed to the Polyphagus Shot Hole borer. They've offered to engaged online to share their experience of dealing with the outbreak, which they note was initially a concern that however changed over a relatively short time, becoming a non-issue. Another connection was with an organisation that works in Cape Town (amongst other cities) to plant indigenous 'forests'. Their work focuses on poor areas and are a City ally in developing climate adaptation and resilience.

Importantly, it has catalysed the belief that even though Cape Town is located in a biodiversity hotspot that is not naturally home to trees, they nevertheless play a role in urban place-making and climate adaptation.

5. OUTCOMES

- 1. A meeting is in the process of being arranged with specialists in California (United States of America) to discuss their experience of the Polyphagus Shothole Borer;
- 2. Feedback to be given to the staff responsible for tree planting and maintenance in the Recreation and Parks Department as part of a workshop they are arranging;
- 3. Renewed discussions around the potential for a Tree Strategy for Cape Town;
- 4. Connections to SUGi, an NGO that work to green cities and reimagine urban life around pocket forests that build biodiversity, climate resilince and well-being in communities. Opportunities to partner will be explored in the coming months;
- 5. Invitation to present to TreeKeepers, an NGO working in Cape Town to protect and maintain the tree canopy; and lastly
- 6. Invitation to the City to participate as a partner and champion in the 2nd Forum on African Forests to be held in September 2024 (tbc) in Johannesburg.

6. ACTIONS REQUIRED

- 1. Organise meeting to discuss Polyphagus Shot Hole Borer learnings;
- 2. Set up meeting to determine appetite and resources for a Tree Strategy for Cape Town;
- 3. Connect with SUGi to learn more about their work and identify opportunities to partner;
- 4. Present to TreeKeepers, date tbc; and
- 5. 2nd Forum on African Forests no immeiate action required. Await final concept note.
