


The proposal entails the following:

CAPE TOWN CBD: Trafalgar Street flower sellers, located between Adderley and Parliament Street

- It is proposed to have 20 trading bays of 4.641m x 2.360m on the site (the bay sizes include the space of the display of flower baskets in front of each bay). A gap of 3.419 meters between bay 14 and 15.
