



# HAVE YOUR SAY! PUBLIC LIGHTS IN KOMMETJIE

The City of Cape Town's Public Lighting Development division receives requests for lights on public roads or streets from across the metro. These requests are investigated in terms of the City's mandate to provide public lights, City policy, and lighting quality standards.

**It is proposed that one of the following two options be adopted at this stage:**

1. **NO.** No more streetlights at this stage please: The existing lights in Kommetjie should remain in place but all future lighting requests must obtain subcouncil endorsement prior to the request being accepted. Wireless and Riverside roads should not be lit at this point and the three new lights erected recently should be removed.

**OR**

2. **YES.** More streetlights please: The City will assess residents' requests for lights as per the standard existing procedure. On approval the road or street in question will be lit.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments from 17 to 31 January 2025.

The City of Cape Town will deploy its data collection team to conduct a door-to-door survey in the unlit areas of Kommetjie from 20 January 2025 until 31 January 2025.
