



HAVE YOUR SAY! PROPOSED INFORMAL TRADING PLAN FOR KHAYELITSHA MALL

The City of Cape Town is mandated to manage informal trading within its area of jurisdiction. It may also by means of the Informal Trading By-law declare an informal trading plan for any place or area, and through this informal trading plan specify dedicated, restricted or prohibited areas for informal trading.

Formal Council approval must first be obtained as part of the process before any area is demarcated as an informal trading area.

The City is in the process of developing an informal trading plan for the Thembokwezi market. All interested and affected parties are hereby formally requested to attend the following public meeting (open day) and to submit comments on the draft plan:

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input to the municipality from 9 March 2026 to 9 April 2026.
