



# HAVE YOUR SAY! PUBLIC LIGHTS IN KOMMETJIE

The City of Cape Town's Public Lighting Development division receives requests for lights on public roads or streets from across the metro. These requests are investigated in terms of the City's mandate to provide public lights, City policy, and lighting quality standards.

Historically Kommetjie has largely not received residential road or street lights due to the residents' desire for Kommetjie to remain predominately unlit.

The department accepts that times and requirements change and that the City has to adapt where a need for change has been verified.

**Accordingly, it is proposed that one of the following two options be adopted:**

1. The status quo remains with a mostly unlit environment, with only some of the major roads or streets lit. No ad-hoc residential lighting requests will be accepted or approved for installation going forward.

**OR**

2. The acceptance of residents' ad-hoc requests for lighting. Upon approval the road or street in question will be lit in its entirety. Applications for individual lights in a road or street will not be entertained.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups are given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input on this proposal to the municipality from 1 to 13 December 2024.
