ABOUT

An Alderman is the historical title derived from the Anglo-Saxon position of “ealdorman”, literally meaning “elder man”. Aldermen are high-ranking members of a municipal assembly or council, chosen by elected members rather than by popular vote or a council member elected by voters.

The title of Alderman is conferred upon a councillor who has served on one or more local government bodies within the Republic of South Africa for 20 years or more.
