# MAKING RECYCLING POSSIBLE FOR YOU

As from 1 July 2023 City of Cape Town's Urban Waste Management Directorate will be introducing the Think Twice waste separation at source programme to your area, which is linked to our new Woodstock Mini-material Recovery Facility (Mini-MRF). This is a free door-to-door dry recycling collection service that requires your participation in contributing meaningfully towards responsible waste management for sustainability.

For this new fortnightly service (every 2nd week of the month) your contractor Ngcokoto Waste **Services** will be collecting your dry recyclables for sorting and recycling.

### Your service schedule key:

- Group 1 in green: The recycling service starts in the first week of July (3 July 2023).
- Group 2 in orange: The recycling service starts in the second week of July (10 July 2023).

The details of the areas covered in Groups 1 and 2 are found on the next page.

This is how it will work:

#### Sort

Each household will be issued with a clear plastic bag. Separate your dry recyclables, i.e.; paper, glass, cardboard and plastics, and place it in the clear bag. First rinse the food scraps, sauces, juices etc. out of your plastic, metal and glass containers, and flatten cardboard before placing it in the bag. Follow the guide as to what can be recycled.

#### Place

Once full, place your recyclable bag(s) out on your collection day (see the dry recyclable

collection service schedule on the next page). Recyclables are collected on a fortnightly basis. You will be issued with a clear bag for each full recyclable bag collected. Should you generate more recyclables, you may request extra clear bags.

# **NO THANK YOU:** WHAT WE DON'T RECYCLE

- Disposable nappies
- Wet, dirty or contaminated items
- Chemicals, paint, motor oil containers, acids or solvents
- Plastic wrap, dog food and cement bags

# YES PLEASE: WHAT WE DO RECYCLE

- Glass: rinsed bottles, containers and jars
- Plastics: all bags and rinsed bottles, tubs, lids, caps etc.
- Polystyrene: Rinsed rinsed tubs and "foam" cups, take-away containers and packaging
- Metal: rinsed food tins, cans and scrap metal
- Rinsed milk and juice cartons
- Aluminium foil
- Clothing or shoes
- Paper: flattened and folded cardboard, any dry and clean paper, newspaper and magazines
