

## Dos and Don'ts when visiting Green Point Park

## You are allowed to bring the following in the park:

- Soft ball for play in the Reddam Field only
- Skateboards, roller blades, push scooters and other fun contraptions, as long as they are used in the designated areas.
- Pets and furry friends as long as they are kept on a leash at all times and do not enter the Biodiversity Showcase Garden.
- Umbrellas, gazebos and other shade equipment, as long as they are only used in the picnic area

## The following are not permitted in the park:

- Alcohol
- Camping
- Dangerous equipment such as knives, explosives, fireworks and firearms
- Fires, braais and gas apparatus
- Hard balls like cricket or golf balls
- Loud music, busking or hawking
- Picking of flowers
- Structures such as jumping castles or gazebos
- Swimming in any of the water features

## Remember:

- All vehicles should be parked in the allocated visitors parking bays
- Benches and tables cannot be reserved or demarcated by visitors
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult
- Litter must be disposed of in the designating rubbish bins before leaving
- Owners are required to pick up and dispose of their dog's excrement.
- Residents enter and use the park at their own risk. The venue, management and staff will
  not be held responsible for any loss or damages.
