About the 'Think Twice' Programme


Think Twice is our free door-to-door recycling collection programme for homes and businesses in selected areas around Cape Town. We appoint contractors to carry out this service.

Instead of disposing all your waste together in one black bag, we encourage you to think twice and use two bags. Separate the recyclable material from the non-recyclable waste.

You can use our Waste Recyclers Map to find out if you live in a 'Think Twice' area. You can also download our Think Twice Dry Waste Collection Areas Map.

How to use the Waste Recyclers Map

• **Step 1:** Open the <u>Waste Recyclers Map</u> and type your address into the space provided to see if your area is a Think Twice Recycling area (see image below).



If the response is **"YES"**, you will be provided with the contact details for the "Think Twice" kerbside recycling collection service provider in your area. You will need to contact them to arrange for inclusion in the programme.

Once you have joined the programme, you will receive:

- the relevant recycling information,
- a clear bag or 140L bin (area specific), and
- a weekly kerbside recycling collection from the appointed City of Cape Town service provider.

Recycle bins

We currently only provide the 140 litre bin to selected areas in the Northern suburbs.

If you live in the northern suburbs, and you contacted Think Twice to join the programme but did not receive a bin, go to one of the following municipal offices:

Durbanville:	38 Oxford St, Durbanville, Cape Town, 7550
Kraaifontein:	Brighton Rd, Kraaifontein, Cape Town, 7570

- We will give you a form to complete make sure that you have your ID with you.
- Alternatively, submit a Service Request (C3) online to receive your bin.

Recycling bins are collected the day after your scheduled refuse collection day.

Damaged/Stolen recycle bin

If your bin has been stolen or damaged, contact our Call centre on 0860 103 089, or submit a Service Request (C3) online.
